

BYLAW NO. 2017-18

LAC PELLETIER REGIONAL PARK

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF UNDEVELOPED PUBLIC HIGHWAYS
WITHIN THE PARK**

Whereas the Lac Pelletier Regional Park and the Lac Pelletier Regional Park Authority are established in the Province of Saskatchewan pursuant to the *Regional Parks Act, 2013*:

And whereas, the Regional Park Authority and the Rural Municipality of Lac Pelletier No. 107 did not have an agreement respecting the administration of public highways within the Regional Park under Section 10(1)(c) of *The Municipalities Act* and land within the Regional Park is not under the jurisdiction of the Rural Municipality per Section 67(5) of *The Municipalities Act*.

And whereas, Section 13 of *The Regional Parks Act, 2013* allows the Regional Park Authority to make bylaws respecting traffic safety on public highways; and


Therefore Be IT Resolved that the Board of the Lac Pelletier Regional Park Authority, enacts as follows:

1. To permanently close of portion of Heritage Drive in NW 12-12-15W3M lying within the limits of Plan 1022133718 and part of Parcel J, Plan 101946629, adjacent to new lots 31,32,33 and municipal buffers MB2 & MB3 as prepared by Gerald Johnson, Altus Geomatics.


