APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS AT LARGE

LAC PELLETIER REGIONAL PARK

PART I: INTRODUCTION

1. Authority

(a) Pursuant to subsection 9(3) of The Regional Parks Act, 2013, the Lac Pelletier Regional Park Authority, hereby enacts this Appointment of Members at Large Bylaw.

2. Title

(a) This Bylaw shall be known as the "Appointment of Members at Large Bylaw" of the Lac Pelletier Regional Park.

3. Scope

(a) This Appointment of Members at Large Bylaw shall apply to the whole of the Lac Pelletier Regional Park.

4. Purpose

- (a) The purpose of the Appointment of Members at Large Bylaw shall be:
 - (i) To provide for the appointment of interested individuals to participate as members of Lac Pelletier Regional Park as provided under The Regional Parks Act, 2013, and

PART II: DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, the following words and terms shall have the indicated meaning, unless otherwise indicated elsewhere in the Bylaw:

INTERESTED INDIVIDUALS means any individual, who, in the executive committees' opinion, has the desire and qualifications necessary to contribute time, energy and expertise to the Lac Pelletier Regional Park Authority. The individual appointed will be eligible for election the executive committee for a term to be decided by the executive committee.

BYLAW means the Lac Pelletier Regional Park Bylaws.

PARK means the area that is designated as Lac Pelletier Regional Parks Authority.

PARK AUTHORITY means the people who are, from time to time, appointed for the purpose of carrying out the management and administration of the Lac Pelletier Regional Park.

PART III: BYLAWS

A. GENERAL

- 1. Members at Large shall be appointed annually by the executive committee by majority vote.
- 2. The Members at Large so appointed shall not exceed 40% of the total number of members and municipal representatives of the Regional Park Authority.
- 3. The appointed Members at Large are eligible for election to the executive committee. The term of service shall be three years unless the member at large is replacing a member of the executive committee with less than three years remaining in their term.
