Storage Sheds on Seasonal Campsites

- 1) Storage sheds are allowed on seasonal campsites as per the following requirements:
 - i. Storage shed applications must be completed and submitted to the General Manager for approval
 - a. One-time fee of \$100.00 must accompany the permit application;
 - b. Scale sketch of all items on the camping site ó trailer, deck, parking and shed must be included;
 - ii. The shed must be installed wholly on the camper site;
 - iii. The shed must not obstruct existing lake views of neighbors;
 - iv. Placement should be adjacent/next to the trailer; and
 - v. The shed may only be used for storage and not for sleeping accommodations.
- 2) All sheds must be purchased through Lac Pelletier Regional Park Authority. The approved seasonal site shed is 6ft x 6ft c/w a 30inch lockable man door, skid mounted, shingled and vinyl sided. Purchase price includes delivery to the seasonal site.
 - i. Shed cost \$2,216 (includes GST); and
 - ii. Shed must be ordered and paid for by November 30 for delivery in the spring.
- 3) Sheds are the property of the seasonal camper.
- 4) The seasonal camper may leave the shed on the camping site provided the winter storage fee is paid. There is no incremental cost to the seasonal camper if the winter storage fee is already being paid for RV storage. If the winter storage fee is not paid, the shed must be removed by September 30.
- 5) All non-conforming sheds must be removed from the campgrounds. Any non-conforming sheds not removed by September 16, 2019 will deemed to be abandoned and removed by the Park.
- 6) Sheds previously installed at The Point as per Bylaw 2015-04 Camping will be inspected and õgrand-fatheredö in if <u>all requirements</u> are met. A shed permit application must be completed by the Seasonal Camper to initiate this process otherwise point 5 will apply.
